



#### PRESIDENT'S PAGE



Apparently I ruffled a few feathers in the bird world with my last President's Page. One writer said that the "hackles on the back of his neck" raised higher and stiffer with each reading. You have to give the guy credit for the ornithological reference in that phrase, and just the thought of it conjures up quite an image. I know of this person, and he has pretty long hackles.

In total, I received letters from three individuals. The text and tone of these communications ranged from critical to vicious and very personal. I've exchanged letters with one of the writers, who incidentally was a SDOU member from Minnesota. That matter seems to have been resolved quite amicably. The mere mention of the receipt of the others is all I plan to do at this time.



My writing alluded to one potential threat to the science of ornithology. The opinion was mine and not that of the SDOU board. I believe that is why they call this the "President's Page," with the president's photo next to the column. Surely, there are more obvious problems that could be written about and probably these would be more popular. If my column had been about habitat destruction, overuse of toxic chemicals, or the crippling of the Endangered Species Act, I am sure I would not have gotten any derogatory comments. The criticism haw been brought on by the fact that I chose to write from another aspect—another view. The very audacity of me to think that the animal rights movement would do anything to stand in the way of science is unthinkable to some.

A business associate of mine told me many years ago that any time you are a pioneer, you had better be prepared to take a few arrows in the back. I write as I do to try to get readers to look at ornithology from another viewpoint. Certainly, it may not be conventional and I may not be the typical person involved with birds, but if some SDOU members only want to read about the pretty birds that I see in my yard, then my column may continue to disappoint those people.

Birds, and ornithology, do face an uncertain future, with threats from more areas than habitat changes. I am concerned about the scientific future and all the potential adversaries of birds. So, this is my best effort at damage control. I understand that the critics will not be satisfied. On this one issue, there is no question that we are on opposite ends of the spectrum. That does not mean that our ultimate goals are not similar. People have always traveled different paths and used different methods in pursuit of their goals. People always will.

#### GENERAL NOTES

BLUE-GRAY GNATCATCHER NESTS AT NEWTON HILLS STATE PARK. On 26 May 1994, I was birding in Newton Hills State Park. At about 6 PM, I was crossing a foot bridge over Sargent Creek that leads to a picnic shelter in the lower part of the park. I heard the distinctive, faint, buzzy call of a Blue-gray Gnatcatcher. Most field guides vary in their phonetic rendering of this call, but I prefer the tsee, or tsseeetti described by the Audubon Society (Ferrand 1983). On subsequent visits I became quite familiar with this call. It is very thin, faint, and hard to notice and it

The creek in this area is a deep gorge covered by old and second-growth trees. The foot path leads to an open, grassy area, about 30 feet from the bank of the creek. As I walked toward this opening, I turned and saw a pair of Gnatcatchers. They darted about and called to each other, both agitated by my presence. I quickly retreated and went to sit under

does not carry very far.

the picnic shelter about 30 feet away. The birds stopped their scolding but stayed close-by. Suddenly, the female flew near and landed on a dead branch of a small American Elm sapling about 20 feet away. She hesitated a little, then slowly hopped down toward the crotch of the branch. Thereupon, she jumped right into a nest, which I had not noticed before. It was so well camouflaged that I never would have seen it had she not drawn me to it. It was a very neat and compact structure made of fine plant down, spider webs, and horse hair, covered with small pieces of aqua-blue lichen, blending perfectly with the color of the tree. The nest was placed about 5 feet off the ground in the lowest crotch of the tree, I watched the bird nuzzle, as if incubating, into the nest. Then it flew off after only a minute or so. Shortly, after both birds departed, I quickly approached the nest and found one egg in it.

When I returned on 30 May at about 10 AM, the nest still contained just one egg. About 1/2 hour later, I ran into Bill and Rosemary Draeger of the Sioux Falls Bird Club and showed them the nest. When I checked the next day, there were two eggs. By 2 June, when Bruce Harris accompanied me, there were four eggs (with no sign of any Cowbird intrusions). Later that evening, I set up my camcorder nearby and recorded the female as she incubated the eggs (these pictures were later shown at the 1994 Fall SDOU meeting). I hoped that this would be a successful nest, but I was a bit concerned that it had been placed in a rather conspicuous and precarious spot—low to the ground and very close

to a well-traveled walkway.

My fears were well founded, as on 10 June, when I next returned, I approached the area to find nothing but silence. The nest was missing. Disturbed and puzzled, I searched under the tree and found the nest intact, but empty on the ground. I will never know the cause, but I feel it was probably predated by either raccoons or one of the feral cats that live in the park. I collected the nest and later donated it to the USD Museum. In spite of the failure of this nest, it was encouraging to find, on 17 July, a family of six Gnatcatchers at a spot about 1/4 mile to the east of this site.

The Birds of South Dakota (1991) lists the Blue-gray Gnatcatcher as a casual visitor and a rare summer resident in the SE. Breeding season reports were made in 1981, 1982, 1983, 1984, and 1985. Clear evidence of their establishment at Newton Hills was reported by Mark Skadsen in 1986, when he found a pair building a nest not far from the spot where I found this one (about 200 yards down-creek, in the same area as the other reports). Later observations in 1989, 1991, 1992, and 1993 by Mark Skadsen, et al., proved that this species was definitely breeding in Newton Hills. One notable record was in 1991. Mark, along with Augie Hoeger, found seven birds, presumably a family, very near the area that the first pair was seen. While there have been a few other reported sightings in South Dakota, one even as far west as the Black Hills, these seem to have been isolated cases and no breeding evidence was noted. Most were of birds seen in May. We might assume that the birds seen in late spring might be attempting to breed.

Newton Hills probably is the only breeding area in the state. As these birds confine themselves to very small territories, other sightings I had within the park lead me to believe that there may be four or more pairs

breeding.

The SDOU Rare Bird Records Committee has listed this species as being well established within Newton Hills, but rare elsewhere in the state.

CHANGES AFFECTING SOUTH DAKOTA IN THE AOU CHECKLIST OF NORTH AMERICAN BIRDS. A few changes in the Thirty-ninth Supplement to the American Ornithologists' Union Check-list of North American Birds" Auk 110:675-682 (1993) affect the South Dakota bird list. The Green-backed Heron reverts to its previous common name, the Green Heron. The Lesser Golden Plover is now to be known as the American Golden Plover. The Rosy Finches are again split into discrete species: The Gray-crowned Rosy Finch, Black Rosy Finch, and Brown-capped Rosy Finch. To the best of my knowledge, the Gray-crowned Rosy Finch is the only species known to occur in South Dakota. Future supplements to the AOU checklist promise many interesting changes to our state list. Dan Tallman, Northern State University, Aberdeen, SD 57401.

HOODED WARBLER IN BROWN COUNTY. I first observed this bird on 23 May 1992 along the James River, south of Aberdeen, Brown Co., South Dakota. I found the bird singing (like a loud Chipping Sparrow) at the top of a small cottonwood. I watched the bird from about 35 feet, using 7x35 binoculars for about five minutes. This was a male, with a yellow body and face, black hood completely encircling the head, no wing bars, olive back, and white tail spots. It looked similar to a Wilson's Warbler, but the Wilson's has a black cap only and is slightly smaller. This record has been categorized as Class 2 by the SDOU Rare Bird Records Committee. **COMMON MOORHEN IN BROWN COUNTY.** On 22 June 1993 I first spotted a Common Moorhen swimming along the edge of a slough about a half mile east of Groton in Brown Co., South Dakota. I knew immediately that the bird was a moorhen, because I remembered seeing them as a boy in Lake County. The most striking feature and the one that separates this bird from the American Coot, is the red bill and forehead. The bird let me get relatively close, whereas the coots in the area scampered. The bird also showed white under wings (side of bird) and did some head pumping. I watched the bird for a while, as it gradually disappeared in the reeds. This record has been categorized as Class 2 by the SDOU Rare Bird Records Committee. *Jerry Stanford*, 108 15th Ave., Aberdeen ,SD 57401.

**GREAT BLUE HERON APPARENTLY FEEDS ON ROADKILL.** On 13 December 1994 at about 11:40 AM. I saw a Great Blue Heron standing in the snow next to an oil road 5 miles south and east of Aberdeen. It looked and flew as though it were healthy. It was apparently feeding on a road-kill, a dead jackrabbit that was on the shoulder of the road. The tempera-

ture at the time was 8° F, with a wind chill of -14°. I could see no open water anywhere near the area, although there could have been some open spots on the James River or Moccasin Creek Jerry Stanford, 108 15th Ave., Aberdeen, SD 57401.

**CUSTER COUNTY RUBY-THROATED HUMMINGBIRD RECORD.** I have reported previously on some "wayward" birds that I have observed at my place in NE Custer County (SDBN 45:9). Habitats in this area are primarily short and mixed-grass prairie. There are some shrubs and small trees at my place.

On 17 May 1994, I was sleeping in my glassed-in screenhouse and woke to see the sun's red orb just topping the horizon. In a Caragana shrub, just outside the east windows, was a very small bird. As I approached, I could see a thin, straight bill, rather long for such a small bird: a hummingbird. I was able to come within a meter of the bird, and watch through the window as it buzzed among the fragrant Caragana flowers.

The light was shadowy in the bushes, but I was able to discern a shiny green back and head. The breast was pale gray, lighter down the center and white towards the throat. The throat feathers appeared black, but several times the bird turned just right, so that those feathers appeared to be a dark, ruby red. I was reminded of the first Ruby-throated Hummingbird I observed in Faulkton in September 1990, which was also at close range, but under broad daylight conditions.

Except for the humming of the wings, the only sound the bird made was a little squeak, as it shook off a Caragana petal stuck to its bill. After a couple of minutes, he flew away to the north. I went to get my camera, hoping to find him in a shelterbelt line of Caraganas. I could not relocate him. The south wind was returning, and would be the dominant weather for the next several days. Previously, the wind had blown strongly all day and into the night of 16 May. I am unsure of how long the predawn lull was on the 17th.

I wrote notes for this sighting immediately afterwards and submitted them to the Rare Bird Records Committee of the SDOU. The committee accepted the report as Class 2. According to *The Birds of South Dakota* (SDOU, 1990), this record was the third South Dakota West River record for the Ruby-throated Hummingbird. *Michael Melius*, *HCR* 89 Box 275, *Hermosa*, SD 57744.

**WINTER RECORD FOR FIELD SPARROW AT SAND LAKE.** On 29 February 1992, I observed this distinct sparrow perched on a fence just north of Sand Lake National Wildlife Refuge. The winter was mild, with little, if any, snow cover. I had a good view from about 15 feet with 7x35 binoculars. The bird cooperated by showing its back, front, and sides. The feature I noticed first was the distinct eye ring and the pink bill. The rusty cap reminded me of an American Tree Sparrow, but the Field Sparrow appeared to be smaller and had no spot on the breast. The bird appeared to be alone and healthy. It flew out into a high weedy field after a few minutes. This record has been categorized as Class 2 by the SDOU Rare Bird Records Committee. *Jerry Stanford*, 108 15th Ave., Aberdeen, SD 57401,

#### **BOOK REVIEWS**

**A BIRDER'S GUIDE TO MINNESOTA**—Kim R. Eckert. 1994. The Pine Knot, Cloquet Newspapers, Cloquet MN. 218 pp. Spiral bound, price not given.

I reviewed the second edition of this guide ten years ago (SDBN 36:56-57). Kim Eckert has managed to improve on a product that was already "a must purchase for a birder traveling to Minnesota." As before, the book includes the state's birding hotspots marked on detailed state highway maps. Every Minnesota county is covered, although some are mentioned very briefly. An index makes the search for specific birds easy. Introductory sections cover ecology, ornithology (including bird clubs, birders, and hotlines), and checklists of mammals, reptiles, and amphibians.

The computer age burst upon us during the last decade, and that has contributed to the aesthetic appearance of this book. It looks professionally done, unlike the homemade look of the second edition. The pho-

tographs are now crisp and the typeset is excellent.

The text is again written the expertise and humor. Ten years ago I had complained about the virtual omission in the guide of Lake Itasca State Park. Kim reluctantly includes a few more details this time, but assures us that Lake Itasca really isn't such a great place to find birds. (I had complained that, finding myself in the park, it was hard for me to figure out what birds to expect.) The problem is that this book is not written for the casual birder: rather it is for the serious lister. When I travel, I bird where I find myself. Others plan their itineraries with specific birds in mind. These latter birders see more species than I do, and they will find Kim's book especially valuable.

We need a guide like this for South Dakota. One way we could begin would be for us to submit guides favorite birding areas to *Bird Notes*. Dennis Skadsen has done this in "A Birder's Guide to Charles Mix County" (SDBN 42:72) and Augie Hoeger in "Birding the Hole" (SDBN 44:52). Dan Tallman, Northern State University, Aberdeen, SD 57401.
