

### **GENERAL NOTES**

### WINTER RECORDS OF THE VIRGINIA RAIL IN SOUTH DAKOTA.

During the winter of 2003-2004, Virginia Rails were found at three different locations around the Northern Black Hills. *Birds Of South Dakota*, Tallman et al. 2002, listed the Virginia Rail as a common migrant and summer resident for most of South Dakota. The sightings reported herein indicate that the Virginia Rail may also be a year-around resident in certain areas of the Black Hills.

The sightings resulted, directly or indirectly, from fieldtrips conducted by the Northern Hills Bird Club (NHBC). In 2003, a decision was made to broaden NHBC fieldtrips to include different habitats, new areas, and night trips, including owling and listening for rails. On 15 July 2003, an evening/night fieldtrip made a visit to the Nisland Slough along US Highway 212 west of Nisland and to the Belle Fourche sewage lagoons north of Belle Fourche. Recorded calls were played of Sora, Black Rail, Yellow Rail, and Virginia Rail at both locations. No responses were received at the Nisland Slough, even though George Prisbe and Anna Ball had observed a Virginia Rail there on 6 July 2002. A Virginia Rail did respond at the Belle Fourche lagoon. The fieldtrip was planned to continue to the Cundy Wetlands northeast of Spearfish, but the stop was cancelled because of a severe thunderstorm. On 21 September 2003, Vic and Donna Fondy played a recording at Cundy Wetlands and a Virginia Rail was both seen and heard. In November 2003, Vic and Donna played the recording for Bud and Alice Shaykett at Cundy Wetlands, with two Virginia Rails (one on each side of the road) responding. On 22 November 2003, Jean and Gene Adams watched a Virginia Rail for 20 minutes at the wetlands on the south side of I-90 exit 2, which is about 10 miles west of Spearfish. On 4 January 2004, Bud and Alice Shaykett, on the way to the Spearfish Christmas Bird Count, made an early morning stop at Cundy Wetlands. They observed a single Virginia Rail, which was later also seen by Donna Fondy and heard by Vic Fondy. On 14 February 2004, the NHBC fieldtrip participants saw a single Virginia Rail at Cundy Wetlands, and two Virginia Rails at the wetlands south of exit 2 of I-90 west of Spearfish. On 6 March 2004, Doug Backlund and Scott Weins found a Virginia Rail at a third location, which was near Spearfish Creek at a wetlands north of Spearfish.

In conclusion, Virginia Rails were found several times at three different locations within 10 miles of Spearfish, SD during the winter of 2003-2004, indicating that the species may be a permanent resident in that area. Checks will be made in the winter of 2004-2005 to see if Virginia Rails are again in residence. *Vic Fondy, 12067 Crook City Rd, Whitewood, SD 57793*.

**AOU CHECKLIST CHANGES.** The 44<sup>th</sup> and 45<sup>th</sup> Supplements to the AOU Check-list of North American Birds were recently published in *The Auk* SOUTH DAKOTA BIRD NOTES 56(3): 65

120(3):923-931, 2003; 121(3):985-995, 2004. The waterfowl and the gallinaceous birds now occur before loons in the checklist sequence. (Anseriformes and Galliformes are apparently closely related and only remotely related to other birds.) The small races of the Canada Goose are now separated from the larger ones, and these small birds are now called the Cackling Goose, *Branta hutchinsii*. The Cackling Goose immediately precedes the Canada Goose in checklist order. The AOU checklist can be downloaded at http://www.acu.org/aou/birdlist.html. Other changes include:

COWBIRDS FOOLED BY STONES. Having an appreciation for rounded rocks, I have amassed a bit of a collection, which I use as decorations in my large garden. In the Spring of 2004, I placed a last year's grackle nest two feet above ground level in the branches of a butterfly bush. Inside the nest, I put three rounded rocks, one gray, one caramel, and one white, each about an inch long. In early June, I was surprised to see a Brown-headed Cowbird egg, smaller, off-white and freckled brown, among those three rocks. That unprotected egg was broken/eaten by, I suspect, a grackle or House Sparrow two days later.

Historically, I have seen cowbird eggs in my yard/garden in the nests of American Goldfinch and have seen a cowbird at least attempting to parasitize a House Sparrow nest. This was the first time I noticed a cowbird fooled by a handful of stones. MyRon B. Zimmer, Bowdle, SD 57428.



## **BOOK REVIEWS**

**BIRDS OF BELIZE.** 2003. H. Lee Jones. University of Texas Press: Austin. Softcover. 317 pp. \$34.95

Although Belize is less than 9,000 square miles in area, this country on the southeastern side of the Yucatan Peninsula boasts a bird list of 573 species. This field guide is indispensable for any traveler to the region.

The book begins with a short, 20-page introductory section. Covered here are a bit about Belize, its ecology, and birds. These notes are followed with a section on how to use the book, avian taxonomy, and plumage and molt. The author devotes a long description on how to identify birds by sound, and the descriptions of calls and sounds throughout the book seem to be robust.

The author makes heavy use of abbreviations in the text, such as C for common, n S.A. for northern South America, and W. I for West Indies. The use of these undoubtedly saves space, but makes the text a bit difficult to read. I am not sure the writing out the word "common," for example, would have significantly added to the bulk of the book.

Most of the book consists of 56 color plates by Dana Gardner. These illustrations are certainly more than adequate to produce correct field identification of birds. If one were to be extraordinarily picky, the birds seem a little flat and not always perfectly proportioned. The bird pictures are identified by numbers that refer to a short written description on the page that faces each plate. It is not always clear to which illustration every number applies, and this could be frustrating in the field.

The plates are followed by species accounts. These accounts concisely cover identification, voice, habitat, distribution, status in Belize, and references. Especially helpful are occasional paragraphs of what to note when trying to identify particular groups of birds. Interspersed in these accounts are rather lovely black-and-white illustrations of various birds. The book ends with 234 range maps, along with references and an index. ## SEASONAL REPORTS

The 2004 Spring Season
1 March 2004 to 31 May 2004

Surpassing the previous high of 325 in 2002, there were 329 species reported (1995-2003 average is 312) during the season. Below, I have tried to highlight the more significant sightings (dates that are earlier/later than listed in *South* SOUTH DAKOTA BIRD NOTES 56(3): 67

Dakota Birds by Tallman, Swanson, and Palmer and species that are out of range). For early/late migration dates, I have listed the three earliest/latest dates (by county). If these dates did not include a sighting East River, West River, and along the Missouri River, I have given the earliest/latest reported date in the missing region also. Finally, included at the end is a list of species that were not reported this year and might be expected during the Spring Season.
